Where:	Taipei, Taiwan
When:	19 – 30 August 2017
Player availability known by:	31st January 2017
Training & Participation Plan Submitted By:	17th February 2017
Teams selected by:	Approx. 20 May, TBC - UTSNZ
Approximate cost:	\$4,000 – approximate guideline
Funding:	User pays Deposit required on advice of selection

NZ based players:

Must play the NZ University Games on 13th May and commit to at least three (3) Open tournaments from the following list:

Canterbury Summer Open – 18th-19th February
Auckland Summer Open - 25th-26th February
North Shore Open – 27th May
South Island Teams – 3rd June
Canterbury Open – 4th and 5th June
Counties Manukau Open – 24th and 25th June
Otago Open – 8th and 9th July
North Island Individual Championships – 14th to 16th July
Waitemata Open – 22nd and 23rd July
Wellington Open – 29th and 30th July
Waikato Open – 5th and 6th August

Overseas based players

- Must provide a detailed 5month tournament participation schedule and regular updated detailed results with rankings of players from matches won.

All players:

- All players must meet the University and Tertiary Sport New Zealand (UTSNZ) athlete and FISU international eligibility criteria at the time of selection, and during the event – see Appendix 1.
- All players wishing to be eligible for selection must provide a 5 month training plan to be reviewed/discussed with regular communication and updates with the National Men's/Women's Coach)
- Training Plans and Tournament Participation must be submitted by all players wishing to make themselves available. Deadline is 17th February. No extension to this date.
- This is a high level event and subject to confirmation of criteria from UTSNZ. Any team submitted must contain at least 1 player ranked in the Top 10 in NZ and another in the Top 20 in NZ.
