## NZ based players:

Must play the NZ University Games on 13<sup>th</sup> May and commit to at least three (3) Open tournaments from the following list:

Canterbury Summer Open – 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> February

Auckland Summer Open - 25<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> February

North Shore Open – 27<sup>th</sup> May

South Island Teams – 3<sup>rd</sup> June

Canterbury Open – 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> June

Counties Manukau Open – 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> June

Otago Open – 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> July

North Island Individual Championships – 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> July

Waitemata Open – 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> July

Wellington Open – 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> July

Waikato Open – 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> August

## Overseas based players

• Must provide a detailed 5month tournament participation schedule and regular updated detailed results with rankings of players from matches won.

## All players:

- All players must meet the University and Tertiary Sport New Zealand (UTSNZ) athlete and FISU international eligibility criteria at the time of selection, and during the event see Appendix 1.
- All players wishing to be eligible for selection must provide a 5 month training plan to be reviewed/discussed with regular communication and updates with the National Men's/Women's Coach)
- Training Plans and Tournament Participation must be submitted by all players wishing to make themselves available. Deadline is 17<sup>th</sup> February. No extension to this date.
- This is a high level event and subject to confirmation of criteria from UTSNZ. Any team submitted must contain at least 1 player ranked in the Top 10 in NZ and another in the Top 20 in NZ.
