



Volunteer Scorebench Official

UTSNZ and Basketball New Zealand, in partnership with the University of Canterbury and Lincoln University are seeking volunteer Scorebench Officials to join us at the upcoming National Tertiary Basketball Championships being held at the Parakiore Recreation and Sport Centre from Friday the 11th to Sunday the 13th of September.

This role will see you assisting as one of four volunteers per scorebench, keeping track of statistics like points and fouls on behalf of the officials and teams. Experience is not necessary and full training will be provided at the event. This is a great opportunity for someone to learn or further develop their scorebench skills and to gain a valuable reference for their CV.

Your key tasks and responsibilities will involve:

- Be part of a roster of volunteer scorebench officials.
- Work with other volunteers to fill the scorebench roles required for basketball.
- Ensure the match documents (e.g. scoresheet) are prepared and ready for each scheduled match.
- Assist the teams and their managers in preparing for each scheduled match.
- Assist the match officials before, during, and after each scheduled match.
- Support the set up and break down of the scorebench areas.

Is this role for you?

This role would be suited to someone who is studying sports coaching or is simply interested in sports and/or volunteering. Without volunteer officials, these events cannot go ahead.

We are looking for someone who:

- Outgoing personality and ability to work as part of a team.
- Experience in scorebench duties beneficial but not required.
- Enthusiastic and motivated approach.
- Ability to take initiative, exercise judgment and work without supervision.
- Conduct oneself in a professional manner by being punctual and reliable.

- No accommodation or travel expenses will be covered.
- Full details of timing will be provided to those who express interest, with assistance required mainly in the mornings and afternoons/evenings.
