KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- You will be the first point of contact for your assigned international team.
- You will be responsible for making email contact with your assigned team prior to their arrival and assisting with any off-water logistics or questions they may have.
- You will greet your assigned team at the airport or hotel upon their arrival and help them through the registration process. A briefing on this process will be completed prior to their arrival.
- You will guide your team through what to expect during the formal Powhiri and join them at the event.
- You will support your team with any translation or cultural liaison that may be appropriate.

This role would be suited to a student who is interested in international studies, politics or management. We are specifically looking for people with the following language skills:

- Portugese x 1
- German x 1
- As well as 6 English

- Is well mannered and has empathy for others.
- Has a can do attitude.
- Is calm under pressure.
- Has well-developed organisational and problem-solving skills.

- Can conduct themself in a professional manner by being punctual and reliable.
