# ENTRY INFORMATION

### Eligibility

- All players must meet the UTSNZ Eligibility and Participation policy which may be viewed in detail on: <a href="http://www.utsnz.co.nz/uploads/116134/files/UTSNZ">www.utsnz.co.nz/uploads/116134/files/UTSNZ</a> Eligibility Policy.pdf
- All UTSNZ Member Institutes shall be eligible to compete.
- All UTSNZ Member Institutes are guaranteed a single team in the Championships. Additional teams will be considered and approved at the discretion of Badminton New Zealand and UTSNZ.
- Non-Member Institutes may apply for participation; however, the approval of entries is at the discretion of Badminton New Zealand and UTSNZ.
- A player may enter one team only.

### Format

- Each team shall consist of a minimum of two female and two male players and up to a maximum or four female and four male players. These players must be the same for the entire event.
- Each tie shall consist of five matches (one Men's Singles, one Women's Singles, one Men's Doubles, one Women's Doubles and one Mixed Doubles).
- Badminton New Zealand has sole responsibility for the creation of the draw. The draw format is dependent upon the number of teams entered. Teams are guaranteed at least 4 ties.
- Times of play will be 9am to 7pm.
- Medals: Gold and silver are awarded for first and second, respectively.
- The competition will be played under the rules of the New Zealand Tertiary National Championships, as distributed and available on the Badminton New Zealand website <u>www.badminton.org.nz</u>
