UTSNZ is seeking volunteer Event Journalists to join us at our National Tertiary Championship events. Event Journalists will assist in finding fun, entertaining and interesting people and personalities involved in the event, creating engaging stories to be used in the promotion and recapping of UTSNZ National Tertiary Championship events.

Your key tasks and responsibilities will involve:

- The primary objective of the Event Journalists is to capture fun, entertaining and interesting content involving sport and the students participating in the event.
- Producing a pre-event article or video to be posted on UTSNZ digital media channels.
- Producing a post-event article or video that summarises and recaps the action of the event.
- Conduct video interviews with student athletes, volunteers, and other event participants.
- Meet deadlines for supplied content before, during, and after event time.

Is this role for you?

This role would suit a person studying journalism, media, communications, or public relations looking to gain on-the-job experience amongst their peers.

We are looking for someone who:

- Ability to approach and be approachable, and communicate effectively with a variety of people.
- Ability to work as part of a team and share ideas with others.
- Good computer skills with your own laptop.
- Ability to meet strict deadlines.
- Ability to take initiative, exercise judgment and work without supervision.
- Conducts oneself in a professional manner by being punctual and reliable.

Key information:

- This is an event time, volunteer role with some time required pre- and post-event.
- No accommodation or travel expenses will be covered.
- Event Journalists need to commit to a minimum of 2-3 hours per day of the event.
- The volunteer is responsible for the insurance and safety of their own gear.
- All content copyright remains with the volunteer for their portfolio post event. UTSNZ will have full usage rights.
- A full induction to UTSNZ, role support and meals (when on shift) will be provided.
