



TENNIS NEW ZEALAND WORLD UNIVERSITY GAMES SELECTION POLICY (2018)

1. THE AIM OF THIS SELECTION POLICY

The aim of this policy is to be used as a guide for selectors and to set out the process of selection for players to compete at the World University Games (WUG) competition.

2. SELECTION PANEL

- 2.1. A selection panel of 2 or 3 persons from the Tennis New Zealand (NSO) performance team (as detailed at www.tennis.kiwi/perform) will select players for the New Zealand WUG Team.

3. PROCESS FOR SELECTION OF THE WUG TEAM

3.1. Eligibility

To be eligible for selection to the WUG Team under this policy, all players must first:

- (a) Meet any eligibility or pre-entry requirements for the WUG as specified by the relevant authorities.
- (b) Shall be playing at a level deemed appropriate to perform with distinction on the international stage – for singles recommended minimum Configure ranking S3.
- (c) Shall have displayed professional behavior at any tennis events they have attended.

4. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION TO THE WUG TEAM

- 4.1. The selection panel will consider the following factors in selecting players for the WUG Team as follows:

- (a) Tournament performances in the past 12 months.
- (b) The future potential of an athlete.
- (c) The athletes conduct.

- 4.2. The selection panel may take into consideration further matters which are relevant to its selection decision under this policy.

- 4.3. The Tennis New Zealand WUG selectors decisions are final, and no appeals process will be entered into.

4.5 Athletes wishing to be considered for selection are requested to e-mail the High Performance Director (currently Simon Rea); simon@tennis.kiwi and attach relevant documentation that satisfies the selection criteria described above.

5. NOTIFICATION OF SELECTION

- 5.1. Players shall be notified by Tennis New Zealand's High-Performance Director (or his or her nominee) whether they have been selected as soon as practicable after the selection panel has made its decision.
- 5.2. Any public announcement of any selections will be made by the Tennis New Zealand.

6. REMOVAL/WITHDRAWAL FROM SELECTION

- 6.1 Should any player subsequently withdraw or be withdrawn from the team for any reason, the Tennis New Zealand selectors shall replace that player at their discretion.
