## National Tertiary 3x3 Basketball Championships 2018

**Teams:**

One men's and one women's team required per entry. Maximum 4 Players on each Team List.

### **Registration Criteria**

All players must have an official FIBA 3x3 profile. To create a profile please log into <https://play.fiba3x3.com/> and follow the sign-up instructions.

### **Cost/Fees:**

TOTAL COST = \$200 per team incl. GST.

Payment to be made to Canterbury Basketball Association at the time of Team Registration.

### **Proposed Format:**

Tournament structure is currently based on 16 teams (8 Men's and 8 Women's) with a minimum of 6 games and a maximum of 10 games per team.

Note, final structure and format is subject to final registrations received.

The number of team entries will be capped at 16 men's and 16 women's teams to ensure a one-day tournament.
